



Dermagun Treatment

What is Dermagun treatment?

The Dermagun is a special device that delivers Redensity - a powerful mix of hyaluronan, antioxidants and vitamins - just under the surface of your skin by creating tiny punctures. Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) can also be added to the Dermagun treatment to provide additional benefits. PRP is the platelet-rich portion of your blood containing concentrated levels of growth factors to enhance healing. Dermagun is a treatment suitable for almost anyone wanting softer, more radiant, healthy skin. It is a quick, effective treatment, with minimal downtime, and is very well tolerated. We can treat your face, neck, chest and backs of your hands.

What does Dermagun treatment do?

Redensity increases the hydration and smoothness of your skin and improves light reflection to give radiance. The hyaluronan in Redensity hydrates and repairs your skin. The special combination of amino acids, antioxidants, multivitamins and minerals is thought to help optimise DNA synthesis and stimulates new collagen and elastin production. The result is visibly smoother, softer skin with improved clarity and skin tone. Aged, dehydrated skin types benefit from Dermagun treatment and occasionally the appearance of fine lines is reduced. For optimal results, we recommend a course of three treatments, spaced three weeks apart, with maintenance treatments every six to twelve months.

Who should not have treatment with the Dermagun?

You should not have treatment if you are pregnant or breast-feeding, have active skin disorders in the area being treated, have hepatitis, chronic liver disease, HIV or known hypersensitivity to the ingredients of Redensity. Caution is required in patients with darker skin types or a history of autoimmune disease, melasma or post-inflammatory pigmentation. If you have permanent implants, filler or recent laser or peel treatments, please inform us. If you are an athlete, please inform us as Redensity contains a compound that could lead to a positive reaction in doping tests.

Are there any possible side effects?

You might experience mild discomfort during Dermagun treatment. Most people tolerate it well with the assistance of our strong numbing cream. Immediately after treatment, you may notice your skin is **red** with small **bumps**. This is temporary and usually lasts up to 24 hours on the face and up to three days on the neck. Small **bruises** lasting up to three days may occur, and can be covered with make-up. Occasionally bruising can last for up to 14 days. In rare cases, temporary **swelling** may occur. Because the surface of the skin is disrupted, rarely **infection** could occur, requiring treatment with antibiotics.

What should I do after my treatment?

For the first eight hours keep the treated area clean, and avoid excessive alcohol and intense exercise. Do not apply make-up for 24 hours other than mineral make-up or a medical camouflage product such as Lycogel®. Do not use active products like retinol, Vitamin A, B or C, scrubs, salicylic or glycolic acid on the treated area for seven days. Wear a zinc-based sunscreen daily, re-applying every two hours, and avoid sun exposure on the treated area.
